- After breakfast, leave for Solang Valley, Sissu, and Atal Tunnel sightseeing.
- En route, we will cover Solang Valley. Enjoy the mesmerizing views from Sissu Valley.
- Upon our arrival in Solang Valley, travelers can indulge in activities like Zorbing, Skiing, ATV rides, Paragliding, Zipline, and more (at personal expense). Once we've had our fair share of adrenaline, we will head back to Manali.
