Day 1: Leh - Arriving Day (Leh Alt. – 11500 Ft)

- Welcome at KUSHOK BAKULA RINPOCHE AIRPORT LEH rest the whole day and let your body acclimatize at Hotel.
- Overnight Stay at The Leh Hotel.

Day 2: Leh – Khardung La – Nubra Valley (Leh Alt. – 11500 Ft; Nubra Alt. - 10080 Ft) (120 KM)

- Start the journey to Khardung -La passes 18380 Ft. The highest motorable road in The World.
- Further, continue the journey toward Nubra Valley.
- Enjoy the scenic beauty and reach the site by evening.
- Overnight stay at Nubra Valley campsite or guesthouse.



Day 3: Nubra Valley – Pangong TSO (Nubra Alt. - 10080 Ft; Pangong Alt. - 15280 Ft) (170 KM)

- We'll see dunes in no-man land, enjoy camel ride & photoshoot.
- The route is less travelled, but the most adventures one. Be ready to test your riding skill. Reach Pangong Lake by afternoon.
- Spend the evening in Camps at lake. Enjoy dinner and overnight stay in camp.

Day 4: Pangong TSO – Leh (Pangong Alt. - 15280 Ft; Leh Alt. - 11500 Ft) (125 KM)

- Be ready with your cameras and phone to click pictures. The view in the morning will take your breath away.
- We will cross Chang La today another highest pass.
- Reach Karu by evening, stay overnight.
- Overnight stay in Leh city.



Day 5: Exploring Leh and around (Leh Alt. – 11500 Ft)

- Wake up late and after breakfast, enjoy your day.
- **Leh Palace:** Start your exploration with Leh Palace, an architectural marvel that offers panoramic views of the city and the surrounding mountains.
- **Shanti Stupa:** A white-domed structure perched on a hilltop. It not only provides spiritual serenity but also offers breathtaking views of Leh.
- **Thiksey Monastery:** Explore Thiksey Monastery, a prominent Buddhist monastery that resembles the Potala Palace of Lhasa, Tibet.
- **Magnetic Hill:** Experience the unique phenomenon at Magnetic Hill, where the layout of the surroundings creates an optical illusion, making it seem like your vehicle is defying gravity.
- **Leh Market:** Wander through the vibrant Leh market, where you can shop for traditional Ladakhi handicrafts, artifacts, and souvenirs.
- **Hall of Fame:** Visit the Hall of Fame, a museum dedicated to the Indian military's contributions to the region.
- Dinner will be served at the Hotel. Enjoy your Overnight stay.

Things to Carry

Must Carry

- Authentic Government ID Card and Driving license for bikers.
- Comfortable warm clothing like woollen socks, caps, fleece jackets or warmers, down jackets and toiletries.
- Sunscreen & lip balm, Good U/V protection sunglasses
- Personal Medicines (if any) & few medicines for altitude sickness (a must)
- Power Banks (No Electricity at Pangong Tso)
- Only postpaid numbers will work in Leh City & apart from that most of the area is no network zone

Gears

- A rucksack bag and a day pack
- 3-litre water bladder or water bottle
- A sun cap and a woollen cap

Clothes

- A sun cap and a woollen cap
- UV protected sunglasses
- One cotton long sleeves and 2 short sleeve t-shirt
- 1 fleece jacket
- 1 heavy Thick jacket/down jacket
- 1 pair of gloves
- At least 2 long pants (trek pants and cargo pants are favourable)
- 4 sets of undergarments
- 2 pair of socks
- A small towel
- A rain jacket or a poncho

Footwear

- Above-the-ankle waterproof and breathable hiking boots with good grip
- Flip flops/sandals

Medication

- One strip of Diamox
- Glucose powder
- Medicines for headaches, diarrhoea, motion and altitude sickness
- Dettol, Bandages & Cotton

Personal Accessories

- Toothpaste, toothbrush
- Paper soap, or sanitizer
- Sunscreen minimum of spf40 , lip balm, cold creams
- Body spray
- LED torch light
- Water bottles and snacks (dry fruits, energy bars, electrol, etc)
- Love for yourself and for every living, and non-living thing

FAQs

Q. Which is the best time for Leh Ladakh Bike Trip?

A. The route from Srinagar to Leh is only open from June to September. So these months are best to make this bike trip.

Q. Which bike you provide for the trip?

A. We provide 4l1cc Royal Enfield Bikes.

Q. Can we have any option in bikes?

A. Yes, you have other options of Bajaj Avenger, Royal Enfield 500, and Himalayan.

Q. Do you have any right-shift gear bikes?

A. No, we don't have bikes with right-shift gears.

Q. What things do you provide with the bike?

A. We provide all the accessories like Carrier, helmets, Gloves, Cans for fuel etc. on nominal charges.

Q. What about the condition bikes?

A. We provide all bikes in perfect conditions, with adding new bikes to our fleet every year.

Q. Is the fuel cost including on this trip?

A. Yes, the fuel cost also included in this trip.

Q. How is the condition of the road during the whole trip?

A. 60% Roads are in good condition, in other 40% you can experience off-road driving.

Q. Do I need to carry a full set of bike repair tools?

A. No, you do not need to carry any kit regarding bike repair. We will provide you with a mechanic and every tool you do need during the trip.

Q. Which transport you provide for the backup vehicle?

A. In the backup vehicle, we mostly provide Mahindra Thar

Q. What riding gear do I need for Ladakh trip?

A. This is the kind of trip riding gear made for. Get a riding jacket, pants, shoes, gloves and a full-face helmet. Keep in mind that all of your riding gear should be good to go against rain, hail and snow.

Q. Do I need to carry thermal wear?

A. Yes, there will be very cold, so it is advisory to carry thermal wear.

Q. What kind of food you provide during the trip?

A. We provide food for 2 times in a day i.e. Breakfast & Dinner.

Q. Do I need to carry any documents with me?

A. Carry an original Driving Licence card and a passport size photograph.

Q. Which language speaks in Ladakh?

A. Ladakhi people speak local Ladakhi language though all of them understand Hindi with some of them (city dwellers) understand English too.

Q. Is there any lack of oxygen during the trip?

A. Anybody travelling 10,000 feet above sea level will find difficulty in breathing or is likely to fall prey to altitude sickness. It happens due to low level of atmospheric oxygen. The biggest cause of AMS (Acute Mountain Sickness) is dehydration. People on the trip forget to drink enough water, they keep on riding. To beat AMS, take the following steps:

- Drink lots and lots of water mixed with glucose.
- Take everything slow. Even little labour at high altitudes will leave you spent.
- Take one Diamox at Srinagar on the morning when you leave for Leh. Diamox takes one hour to start working.
- Don't push too hard; take the trip slowly. Ascent slowly, decent.
- If you feel the symptoms creeping up, stop and take some rest. Don't keep pushing.

Q. What about money exchange, can we use Debit/credit cards?

A. Money can be exchanged only in Srinagar & Leh town; you can also use debit/credit card in a few of the reputed shops and hotels but at an additional 2% service tax.

Q. Which network is accessible?

A. During the whole trip you can get BSNL network at some places, in Srinagar you can get every mobile network but in Ladakh region, you can only access postpaid BSNL, Airtel and Vodafone.



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
